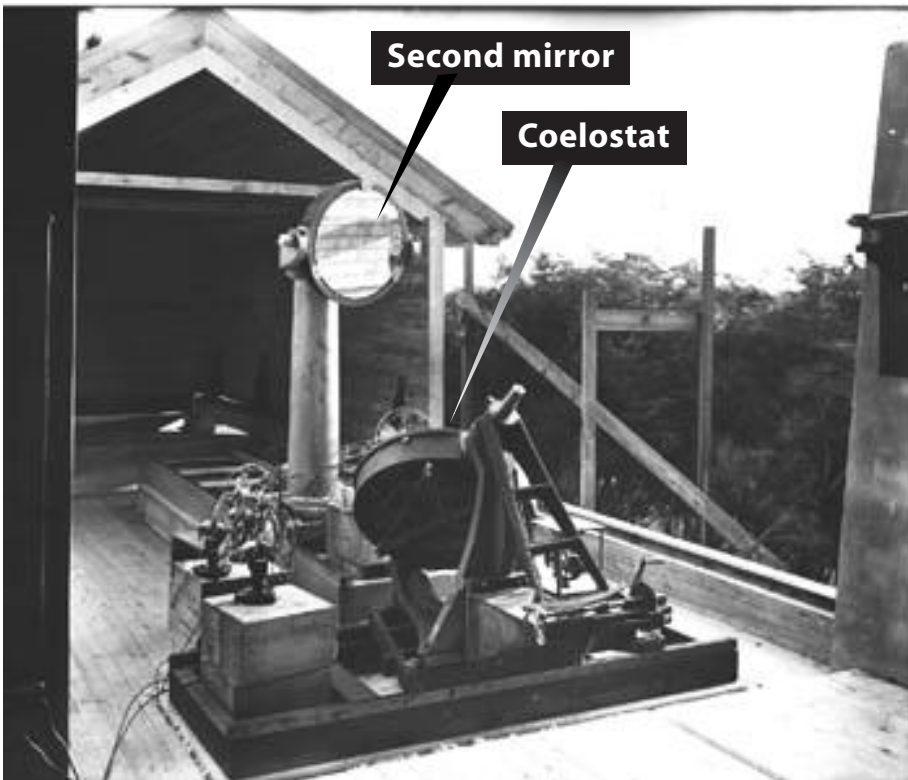


## The Snow telescope



The horizontal building on Mt. Wilson that houses the Snow telescope's mirrors.



Two of Snow's three mirrors are shown. The lower mirror (the "coelostat," seen from behind) tracks the Sun and sends its light to the second mirror (on tall support post). From there, the light is bounced to the primary mirror (not shown), which is sheltered in the long shed-like building.
